What: The City Promotes Scott Wisby to Public Works Director

LOVELAND, OHIO: It is the City's pleasure to swear in Scott Wisby as the City's new Public Works Director at the January 12, 2010 City Council meeting. Mr. Wisby brings nearly 15 years of public works experience to the position, including more than two years as Loveland's Deputy Public Works Director. He is a veteran of the United States Army, having been deployed to Somali with the 10th Mountain Division during Operation Restore Hope. Mr. Wisby ran day-to-day operations for the Department of Public Works throughout 2009, giving him the hands-on experience and familiarity with the City, its residents, and the community's infrastructure.

During his time in Loveland, Scott has overseen numerous capital projects ranging from water replacements to road resurfacing to park renovations. He also led the City's response to two snow emergencies, a flood which blocked State Route 48, and the recovery from Hurricane Ike in September of 2008.

Mr. Wisby will step into the shoes of long-serving Public Works Superintendent, Larry Moreland, who will retire this year after more than 13 years with the City. Named Public Works Superintendent in 2003, Mr. Moreland's more than three decades of public works field experience includes six years spent improving the equipment and training for his department. His most notable accomplishments include the construction of the new public works garage and the second salt storage dome, as well as upgrading the quality and versatility of the City's fleet.

Loveland City Manager Tom Carroll said, "While the City will certainly miss Larry Moreland's seasoned leadership, we wish him the best in his retirement and we are lucky to have someone as skilled as Scott Wisby in place and ready to take over. Scott is the perfect choice, a highly respected, motivated team leader who will walk the extra mile to serve Loveland's residents and continue to improve the Public Works Department."
