What: City of Loveland Announces 2010 Road Rehabilitation Streets

LOVELAND, OHIO - The City of Loveland is pleased to announce it will commence its 2010 road rehabilitation program starting June 21<sup>st</sup>. The 2010 program will begin with crack-sealing repairs, milling and FiberMat installation the week of June 21, 2010. Black mat installation or paving is scheduled to be performed the week of June 28, 2010. The work should be completed by July 1<sup>st</sup>, weather-dependent. On-street parking will be temporarily restricted, but traffic will be minimally impacted by these repairs.

The following roads are scheduled for repair or resurfacing:

Strawser Construction will be the contractor again for the 2010 road work; they were the City of Loveland’s contractor for the 2009 road rehabilitation project as well and earned

the opportunity to do this work through a competitive bid process. The City has budgeted \$250,000 for general road repairs in 2010 which will resurface 1.46 lane miles of roadway. The City will be resurfacing 1.3 miles of roadway as part of its 2010 waterline replacement project also.

Mayor Weisgerber noted the City's stable financial condition and careful fiscal stewardship has enabled the City to continue to invest in roadways. "Loveland is fortunate to have as much revenue as we do to invest in our roadways as we do this year. Many communities are deferring basic maintenance due to the economy. Loveland is not because of careful fiscal management."

Strawser Construction will give residents, living on streets receiving the surface treatment, notice the night before the work will be done so they can make necessary arrangement for alternative parking and ingress/egress. The Public Works Department will also be performing crack repairs on West Loveland Ave between Riverside Dr. and 3rd St., and in the Brandywine Subdivision on Country Down Lane (North of Brandywine Lane), High Cliff Court, Silver Fox Court, Bonnie Heath Court., and Hawks Ridge Court.
