## Loveland Police Division Citizens Police Academy

The Citizens Police Academy is designed to promote a better understanding between citizens and Police Officers through classroom and field training. Participants will learn about the function and training of Officers through various methods. Our goal is to develop relationships and support between Police Officers and the citizens of Loveland.

The CPA is an eleven week course. Featured speakers will be Police Chiefs of Police, Police Officers, a Judge, K-9 and the City Manager. The program includes a ride along with an Officer, tour of the Safety Center and the County Jail.

Participants will be educated about many law enforcement topics including , Search & Seizure, Domestic Violence, K-9, O.V.I. to name a few. Class members will also have the opportunity to use the Police Firearms Simulator.

### Application and Academy Requirements

1. You must be over 18 to apply.
2. **Priority will be given to those living or working within the City of Loveland.**
3. A criminal history check will be conducted. Approval must be given by the Police Chief for anyone with a criminal record to be admitted.
4. Appropriate business attire and the provided identification badges are required to be worn during all training activities, including tours and riding assignments.
5. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Class size is limited.
6. Participants are not permitted to carry weapons.
7. Participants must conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times.
8. Incomplete applications can not be processed.
